

THE TRUTH ABOUT THE SCRIPTURES

According to 2 Tim 3:16-17 ALL scriptures are inspired of God and are profitable for doctrine, for reproof,(rebuke) for correction and for instruction in righteousness that a man may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. This discussion will show what the scriptures are and some of it's revelations. This is one of the first things a person needs to know to discern biblical truth.

A summary of what the scriptures are is in Luke 24:27,44-45. It say's they are Moses(the law), all the prophets and the psalms.

Another very important fact about the scriptures is that they are about Jesus. The following verses will confirm the above points.

2 Tim 3:15 says Timothy from a child has known the scriptures (the new testament was not written yet).

John 5:39,46 Luke 24:27 Acts 18:28 say the scriptures are about Jesus.

Rom 16:26 the mystery of the gospel revealed by the scriptures of the prophets.

2 Peter 1:20-21 prophesy in scripture came by inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:16 scripture about Judas betrayal came from King David by inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 10:43 all the prophets witnessed that Jesus would take away sins.

Rom 1:2 the gospel was foretold by the prophets.

Rom 15:4 the scriptures through patience and comfort would give us hope.

Matt 5:17-18 the law and all prophesy fulfilled at the cross.

Mark 12:10 refers to Psalm 118:22 as scripture. The stone the builders rejected is become the head of the corner.

John 7:42 scripture says the Christ comes from the seed of David and Bethlehem.

1 Cor 15:3 according to the scriptures Christ died for our sins, was buried and rose again.

Acts 17:2 Paul taught from the scriptures.

Acts 17:11 the Jews searched the scriptures to confirm Paul's teaching.

Acts 18:24-28 Apollos from the scriptures showed the Jews Jesus was Christ.

Matt 26:54-56 Jesus said all he did was so the scriptures of the prophets be fulfilled.

2 Peter 3:15-17 Paul's writings (from the scriptures) as well as other scripture was not understood by some to their destruction.

All quotes of the old testament in the new testament are from the scriptures.

Jesus validated that scripture was accurate and could be trusted as true.

There is no quote in the new testament saying it is scripture.

If a new testament writing quotes scripture it is a valid truth.

We should believe what the bible says is truth (scripture) not what we think or were told by someone.

Most of the new testament i'm sure is accurate and supplies great information, but correct doctrine is too important to be wrong about. We have a more sure word : The Scriptures.
